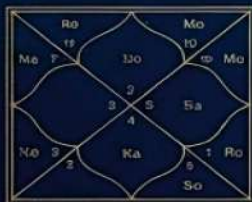


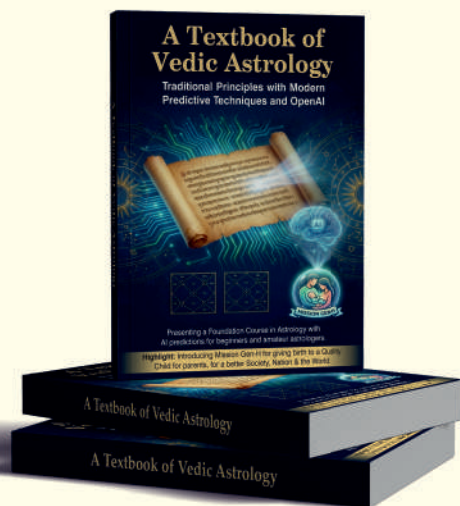
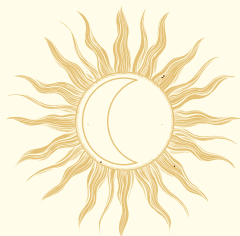

VJM further provides detailed planetary aspect analysis, Kundali Strength Indicator (Guna Ank), comprehensive evaluation of Yogas and Doshas, Mangal Dosh and Kaal Sarpa Dosh status, Saade Sati projections, and Nadi Dosh classification.

Vedic Mahakundali represents a significant step forward in predictive astrology, offering insights and analytical capabilities not available in conventional Kundali systems.

## What Makes This Book Presentation Unique: The Author's Perspective.

Astrology has been explored by hundreds of scholars and documented in thousands of publications, many authored by highly learned and traditionally trained astrologers. This book, however, stands apart in both its approach and application. It is not written from the standpoint of inherited practice alone, but from the perspective of a cosmology researcher examining astrology as a living, evolving system aligned with Nature's design.

Through scientific inquiry, the author observed that the Earth System creates human life by integrating all natural elements during the process of parenting. At birth, a newborn is uniquely programmed by aligning its existence with planetary coordinates relative to its precise time and place of birth. This understanding forms the book's foundational philosophy.

During deeper study, it became evident that while society has evolved dynamically, Vedic Astrology has largely remained static. Some 20th-century researchers attempted modernisation by including Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto, but this work adheres to classical Vedic Astrology, considering only the Planets up to Saturn. This traditional Horoscope-casting method is known as the "*Paramparik Padhati*" (*Traditional Method*).

To align astrology with present-day realities, the author introduces a refined system called the "*Adhunik Padhati*" (*Modern Method*). While retaining the traditional 36-Guna Milan system, the book incorporates additional factors essential for modern marriage compatibility. In today's context, a wife is educated, empowered, and economically independent, contributing equally to family stability and success, an important social shift not reflected in ancient frameworks.

Another key societal change addressed is the evolving priority of childbirth over the long-term couple's compatibility. While classical astrology places heavy emphasis on *Nadi Dosh*, the author identifies and explains Anshik (partial) *Nadi Dosh*, which can result in delayed childbirth rather than total denial. The revised Guna Milan methodology is presented in detail in Chapter 11.

A significant innovation supporting this work is the Vedic Jyotish Mahakundali (VJM Kundali) software, available for free on the Android Play Store and the ARF website. VJM Kundali provides the Jatak's (individual's) Guna Bal (strength) and clearly displays planetary aspects within the respective Houses of the Horoscope, enabling more precise and objective predictions.

The most distinctive feature of VJM Kundali is its ability to merge two or more Horoscopes. When matchmaking a couple, the merged Kundali reveals their combined planetary impact, something traditionally dependent on an Astrologer's intuition and mental calculations. Similarly, merging family Horoscopes offers insights into the family's collective wealth, income flow, assets, expenses, and losses.

Backed by over 20 years of research and analysis of more than 200 Horoscopes, VJM Kundali has demonstrated encouraging accuracy and reliability. It also identifies Sade Sati, Kaal Sarp Dosh (partial or complete), suggests Gen-H birth timing for a quality childbirth, and provides space for astrologers' remarks and recommendations.

With these integrated advancements, this book and its accompanying tools offer astrologers a practical, modern, and research-backed evolution of Vedic Astrology. A human being can be understood as a uniquely programmed entity, endowed with the freedom to act independently, yet deeply influenced by inherent design and cosmic order. Every individual is born to a specific parent, on a particular date, at a particular time, and at a particular place. These four factors, i.e. **parentage, place of birth, date of birth, and time of birth**, define the foundation of one's characteristics, behaviour, destiny and life journey.

The moment of birth is profoundly significant. It not only determines one's physical attributes, such as appearance, complexion, and gender, but also shapes personality, behaviour, relationships, and even the role the newborn plays in altering the lives of parents, siblings, and close relatives. Birth sets in motion a complex interplay of influences that extend across emotional, financial, and spiritual dimensions.

This book seeks to decode the human program through the lens of astrology. It explores how a Horoscope, comprising nine Planets, twelve Constellations (*Rashis*), and twelve Houses, serves as a blueprint of life. A Horoscope (*Kundali*) has two distinct dimensions:-

1. **Astronomy:** It provides the precise position of Planets with their coordinates in relation to Constellations (*Rashis or Nakshatras*) within the Zodiac.
2. **Interpretation:** An astrologer translates these Planetary positions by applying the Laws and the rules of Astrology into insights about human character, behaviour, relationships, opportunities, challenges, and the unfolding of one's destiny and events flow through the journey of life.

Through this systematic framework, astrology provides a means to understand every aspect of human existence, emotions, health, professional career, income, wealth, partnerships, gains, losses, debts, enemies, inheritance, lifespan, and even the circumstances of death. Predictions emerge from carefully studying the dynamic relationship between Planetary positions at birth and their current motion in space.

- I. How to research and interpret various aspects of human life through Horoscopes.
- ii. Methods to rectify birth time for accurate predictions, ensuring precise predictions and forecasts.

## The Divine Message of Astrology

Astrology is not merely a predictive science; it is a form of divine knowledge rooted in Nature's laws. *Jyotish Vidya* operates through the precise observation of planetary movements in relation to the Zodiac constellations (*Rashis*) at a specific date, time, and place of birth. These celestial positions reflect Nature's programming of human life, *Vidhi ka Vidhaan*.

*Jyotish* adopts a geocentric perspective, observing the sky as seen from Earth. This approach enables planetary motions to be mapped in a manner meaningful to human life. The movements of planets across the Zodiac are recorded in astronomical charts preserved in the *Panchang* (*almanack*). Every individual, born at a unique moment and location, receives a distinct celestial imprint known as the Horoscope or *Kundali*.

By interpreting a *Kundali* according to established astrological laws and rules, one can understand an individual's nature, tendencies, behaviour patterns, and major life events, which we often call destiny. Just as science functions through defined laws, *Jyotish* also operates through natural and *Jyotish* laws, as explained in this book.

When these principles (*Laws and rules*) are applied to the Horoscopes of persons closely known, parents, siblings, children, relatives, or lifelong friends, one can compare the Horoscope predictions with the real life characteristics and events happened in the past, and the present and predictions can be made for the events in the future. This reveals the silent intelligence of nature guiding every life in the background.

Astrology serves as a bridge between Nature's system design and human activity. Human life is not isolated; it is integrated into a vast cosmic network that manages the Solar System and synchronises it with deeper Universal processes, far beyond human awareness. All living beings function like neurons in a human brain. Just as neurons coordinate bodily systems, living beings on Earth act as neural units of the Solar System, collectively managing its functioning while remaining connected to the Universe in deep space through the Zodiac constellations.

From this perspective, the human population network acts as the cognitive system of the Solar System. *Jyotish Vidya* further reveals that planets and constellations possess genders, much like living beings. The Moon, Venus, and Earth are considered female; the Sun, Jupiter, and Mars are male. Saturn is physically male but sexually neutral, while Mercury is gender-neutral. Among the Zodiac signs, Aries, Gemini, Leo, Libra, Sagittarius, and Aquarius are male, while Taurus, Cancer, Virgo, Scorpio, Capricorn, and Pisces are female.

These gender principles explain growth, coupling, and expansion, not only among humans and earthly life forms, but also among celestial bodies. As human populations expand, so does the Universe. Just as humans naturally seek expansion of knowledge, assets, land, Houses, or influence, the Universe itself is in a state of continuous expansion.

All human beings are service providers, serving one another through their talents to sustain the world population in its entirety. Similarly, the Universe functions through mutual service among celestial bodies. The Sun provides energy; the Earth sustains life; the Moon governs tides, stabilises oceans, and connects all living beings, much like modern satellite constellations connect global communication and navigation systems.
